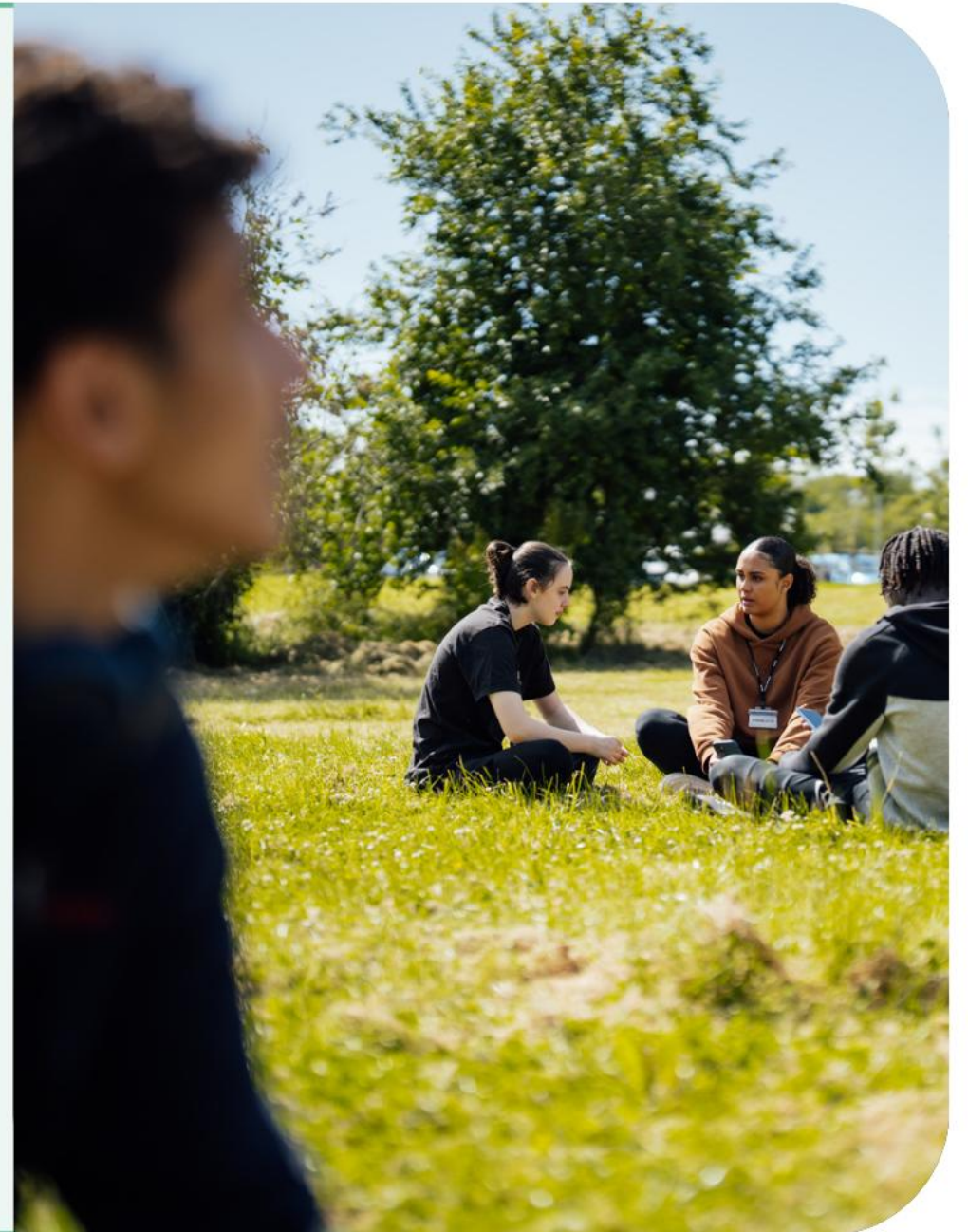

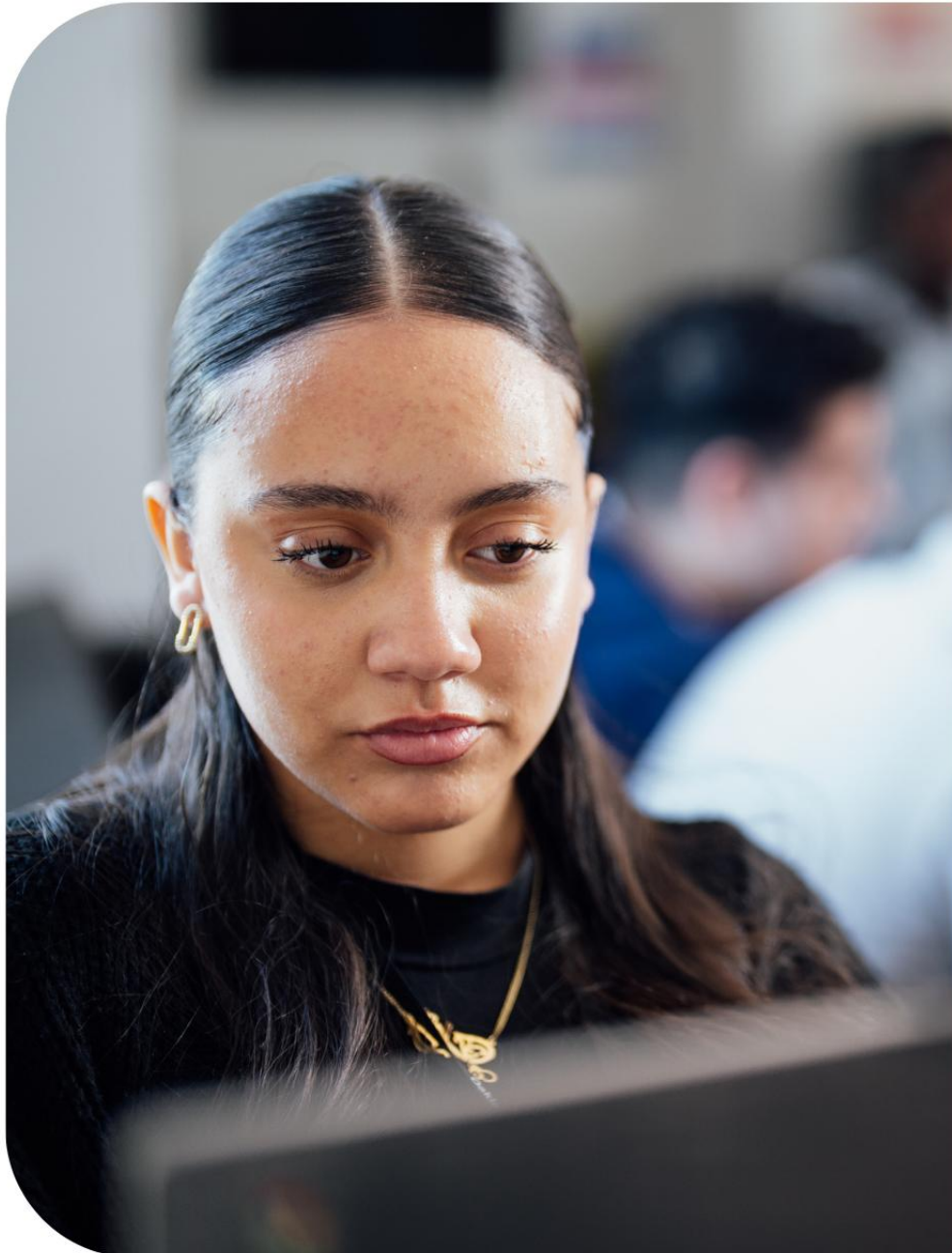

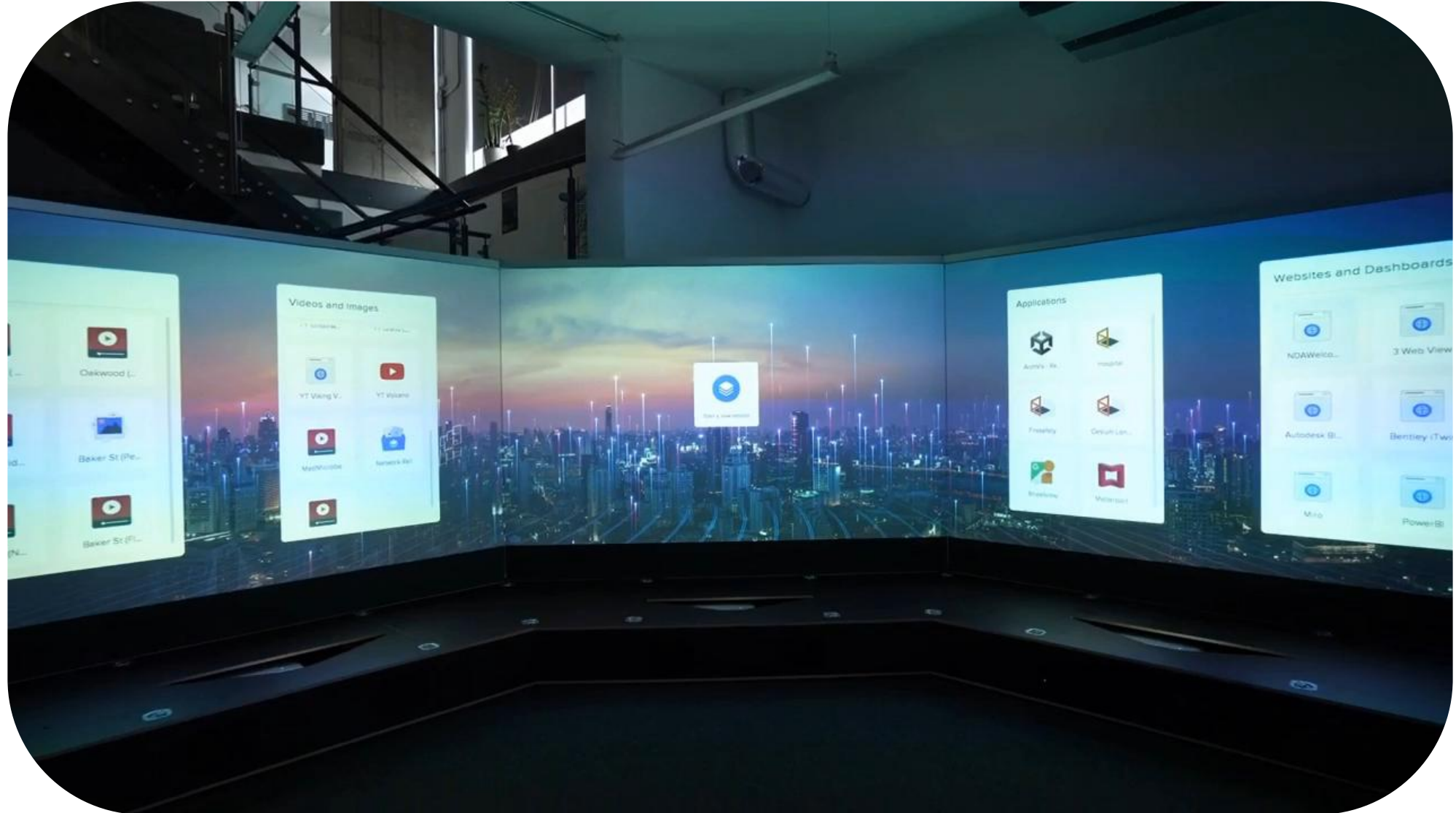

# APPRENTICESHIP FACTS

You can start an apprenticeship if you're:

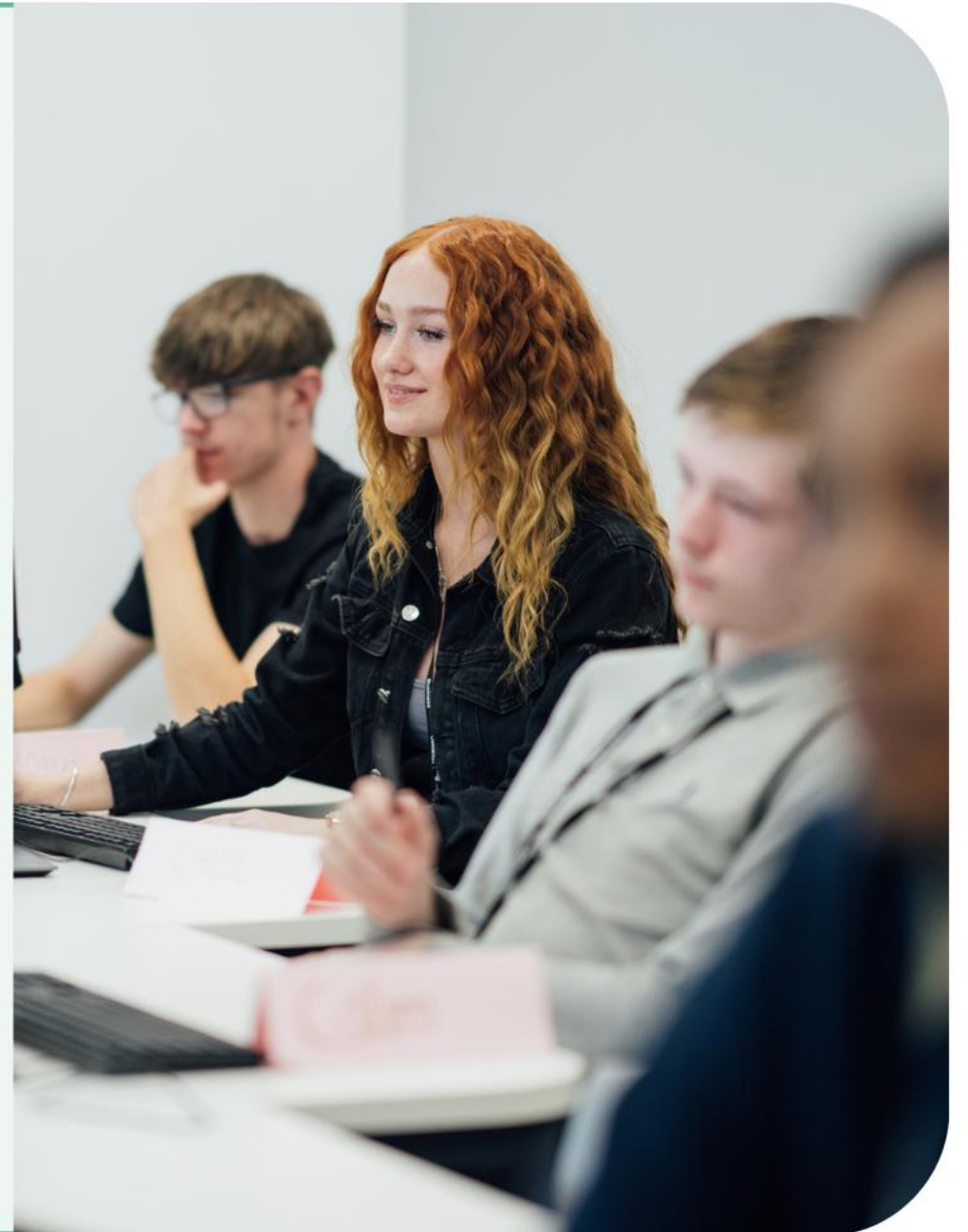
- 16 or over - there's no upper age limit and not in education (full or part-time)
- An apprenticeship is a real job
- Apprentices are paid a salary
- Apprenticeships last a minimum of 12 months
- Apprenticeships range from level 2 to level 7
- Apprentices do not pay for their training
- Apprentices will receive paid off-the-job learning
- Apprentices will spend the majority of their time on-the-job

You can have a previous qualification, like a degree, and still start an apprenticeship.

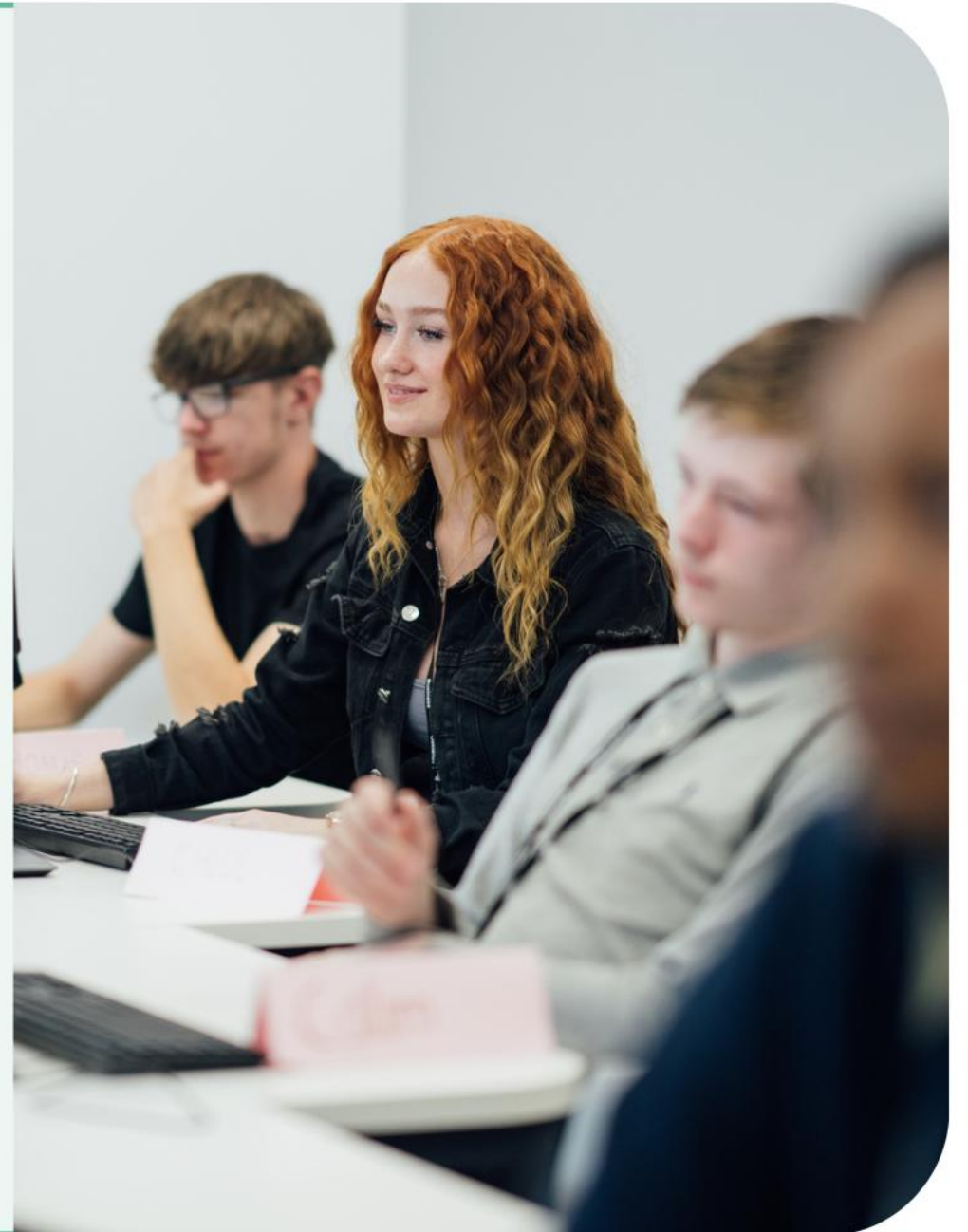

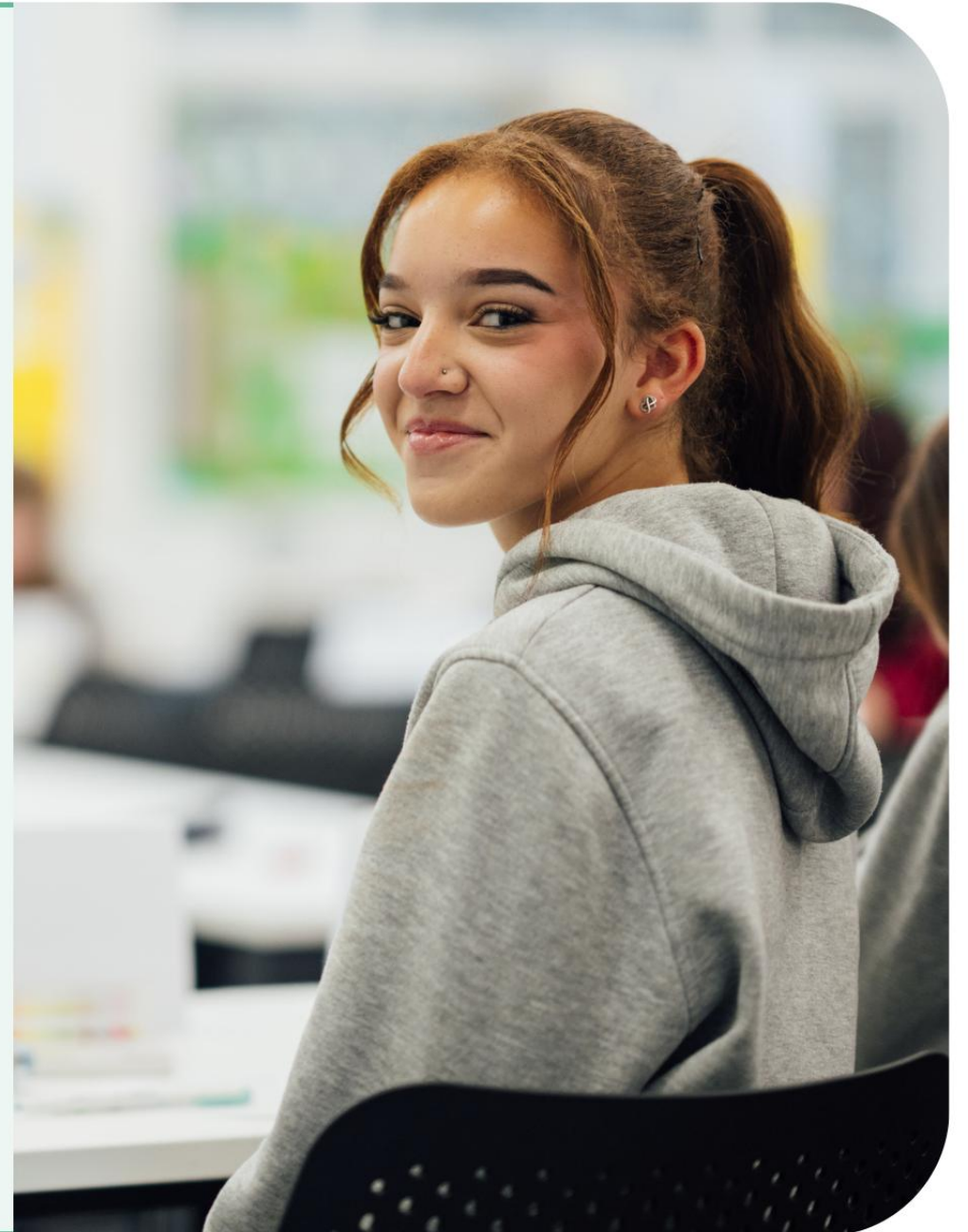
